The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four (4), has scheduled two (2) similar Project Kick-Off Meetings for the SR 9/I-95 Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study from south of SR 870 (Commercial Boulevard) to south of SR 808 (Glades Road) in Broward and Palm Beach Counties, Florida. Identical information will be presented at both meetings.

These Kick-Off Meetings are being held to briefly introduce the project and to obtain public input. These meetings will be conducted in an open house and participants are welcome to come at any time between **5:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.** At the meetings, a brief presentation on the project background and purpose will be given and aerial maps will be on display. FDOT staff and consultant representatives will be present during the specified hours to informally discuss the project, receive public input, and answer questions. These are informal public meetings, not a public hearing. We invite and encourage all interested persons to attend these meetings to review and discuss this significant transportation improvement project.

The first Kick-Off Meeting will be held on **Tuesday, February 27th, 2007** at the Florida Department of Transportation, District 4 Auditorium located at 3400 West Commercial Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33309. The second kick-off meeting will be held on **Wednesday, February 28th, 2007** at the Florida Atlantic University, Live Oak Pavilion located at 777 Glades Road, Boca Raton, Florida 33431.

These Kick-Off meetings are conducted in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968. Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability, or familial status.
